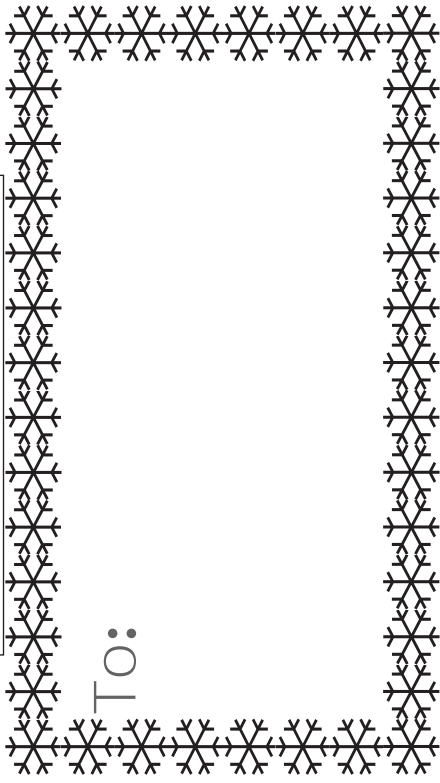

## What is HIPAA?

**HIPAA Overview:** To improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the health care system, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996 included a series of “administrative simplification” provisions that required the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to adopt national standards for electronic health care transactions. By ensuring consistency throughout the industry, these national standards will make it easier for health plans, health care clearinghouses, doctors, hospitals and other health care providers to process claims and other transactions electronically. The law also requires the adoption of privacy and security standards in order to protect individually identifiable health information.

## What does it mean if I check the NO boxes on the PSA Membership Application?

If you check the NO boxes on the PSA membership application it means that if you or a member of your family are sick or hospitalized, it will not be published in the “Caring and Sharing” section of the PSA newsletter or announced at the monthly business meeting. We care about you and your family, but we also want to respect your privacy.

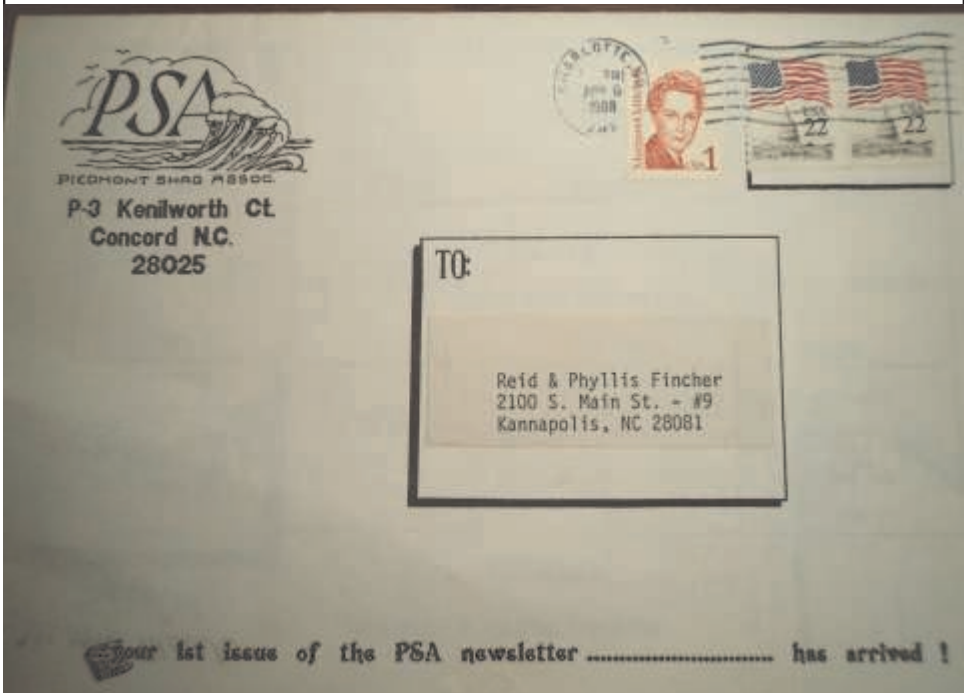
